The President of the program was Prof. K P Narasimha Murthy, President APS Educational trust, and event was graced by General Secretary, Vice President, Joint Secretary and Mentor and Trustee,Sri Mohan Dev Alva of APSET

The programme commenced with the guests being taken to the dais with traditional folk danceof Karnataka, namely, "Tamate Vadya" and "Dollu Kunita", by our students both girls and boys.
