
Report on the 71" National Constitution Day Celebration 26.11.2021





All the staff and students took the constitutional pledge and sung the National Anthem.



131ST Birth Anniversary of constitution architect, Bharat Ratna Dr. B.R Ambedkar Jayanthi was celebrated with great nationalistic and patriotic fervor on 18th of April,2022 at 1 p.m. at the new seminar hall.

Prof. Shashidhar, Faculty of PG Department of History, Bangalore University Jnana bharathi campus, Bangalore, was the chief Guest and Resource Person for the celebrations. Dr. B. Jayashree, Principal in her introductory talk said that, education is the savior for one and all. Madam highlighted the courage and confidence with which Ambedkar rose in his life and such great leaders should be emulated by the younger generation. In his address to the audience, Prof. shashidhara provided glimpse of the British rule in India as well as detailed biographical sketch of Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar. The speaker highlighted the principles and ethics that Ambedkar stood for. 



Karan V student of PG Economics led a group song that highlighted the inner strength and spirits of differently Abled.







