**TEN DAYS CRASH COURSE ON "SCHOLASTIC ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME FOR
FACULTY AND POST-GRADUATE STUDENTS"**

The department of Post-Graduate Studies in Economics has organised Ten Days Crash Course on "*Scholastic Enrichment Programme for Faculty and Post-Graduate Students*" in Association with IQAC form 2nd Week of February 2021 to last Week of April, 2021. On every Saturday, the classes were taken during 2:00pm to 4:00pm. The crash course started on 20/02/2021 and ended on 22/07/2021. Due to Lockdown during COVID-19 pandemic, the classes were extended until 22/07/2021. The Programme was inaugurated by Dr. B. Jayashree, Principal, APS College of Arts and Science on 20/02/2021. 
Subject: Report on Webinar on World Earth Day Celebration 2021.

A Webinar was organized to celebrate World Earth Day on 22-04-2021 by the Department of Botany and Eco-club at APS College of Arts and Science, N. R. Colony, Bangalore. The webinar was attended by senior faculty members, HOD's of all the departments, teaching and non teaching staff and students. Prof. Sathyappa Nayaka M.J, Department of Botany, briefed the importance of world Earth day as an annual event celebrated around the world on April 22, to demonstrate support for environmental protection and represents a day of action to shift human behaviour and provoke policy changes. The very first celebration took place in 1970, and by now it grew to a staggering global event with celebrations in more than 193 countries involving over a billion people.

Given the urgency of the shared challenge we are facing on Earth, the main objective of this webinar was to present the link between environmental issues and the current health crisis (COVID-19). The emphasis was on two main drivers: i) rapid urbanization and ii) loss of biodiversity and ecosystems, as well as the consequences: hotspots of zoonotic diseases. The conversation addressed how population density, population size, and airline connections explain the rapid spread of COVID-19, and also touched on the ways the global response is providing evidence that coordinated environmental interventions (such as climate or pollution mitigation efforts) can be effective. Moving forward with the reality of a world in which COVID-19 plays a central role, the discussion also focused on cities and how mapping vulnerable populations can be instrumental for decision making.

Dr. B Jayashree, Principal, APS College of Arts & Science spoke on in identifying and predicting the origins and impact of emerging diseases across the globe, as well as the fundamental connections between human and environmental health. She also emphasized on committed to supporting activities that strengthen the conservation and protection of natural resources, advance ecological sustainability, and foster harmony between communities and the environment. She summarized the following issues regarding


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- Protecting and restoring land, coastal, marine, and freshwater resources
- Enhancing the capacity of communities to support natural resource management and conservation
- Supporting sustainable agriculture, fishing, and aquaculture practices
- Addressing the cause of climate change by reducing the emission of greenhouse gases
- Strengthening ecosystems and communities affected by climate change
- Supporting education initiatives that promote behavior that protects the environment
- Advocating for sustainable consumption to build an economy that uses resources more efficiently
- Addressing environmental justice issues and public health concerns

Prof A Prakash, Joint Secretary, APS Educational Trust spoke and encouraged all to engage in programs and activities that will promote an understanding of environmental protection, the urgency of climate change, and the need to create a healthier, safer, more equitable future for all people.

The Webinar was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr. Narsimha Parvatikar, HOD, Department of Physics, APS College of Arts & Science.



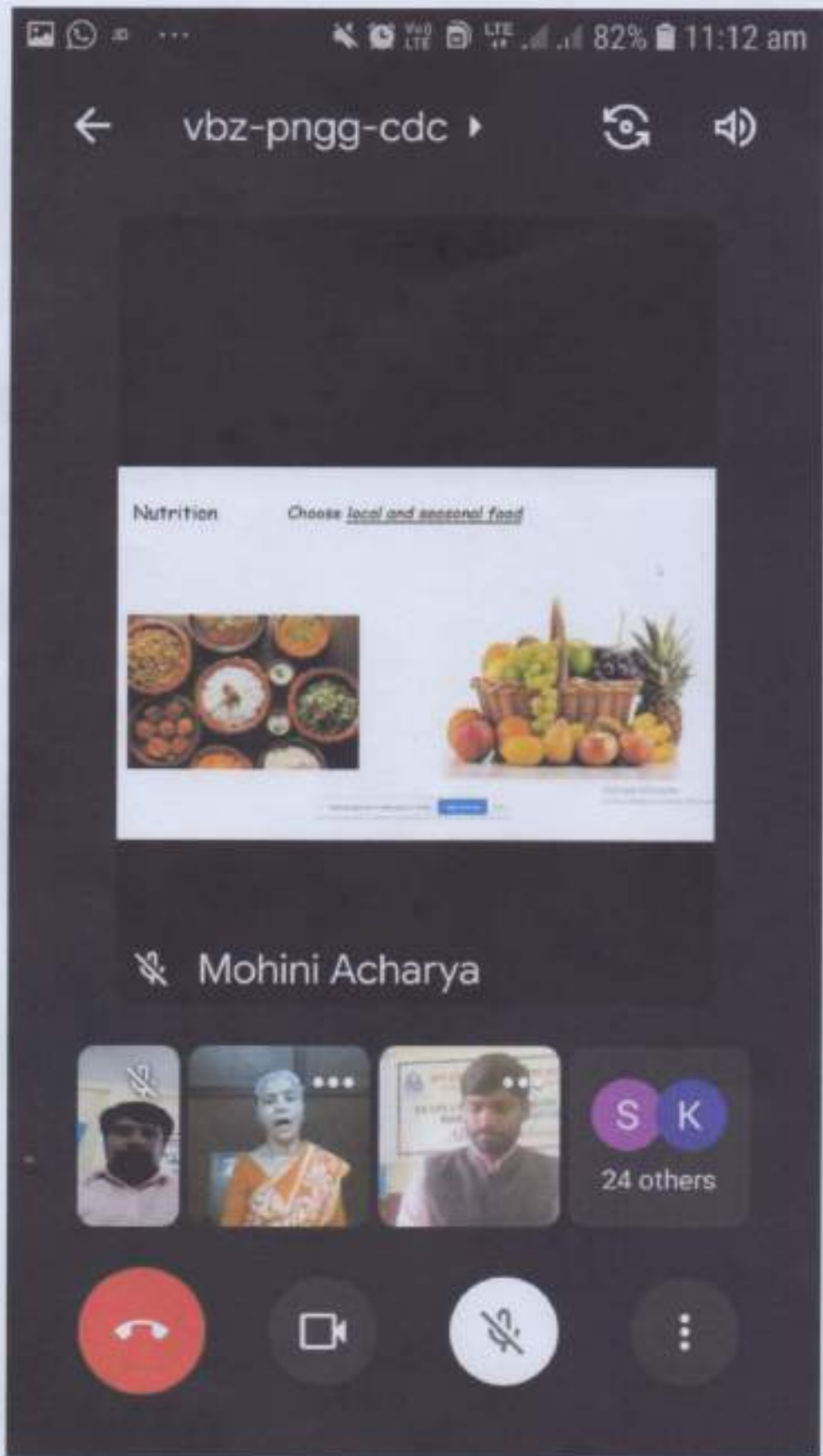
