1. To arouse the curiosity towards science amongst students.


2. To inform the contribution of global science for wellbeing of humanity.

1. Created awareness among all the streams of students regarding scientific development in and around the globe.


2. Students and staff were enthralled about the significance of ceramics from lab to land, and they were exposed to vast area of research in material science particularly in the field of ceramics.
