The event was presided by Dr.B.Jayashree in the presence of Smt.Sukeshni.T.V and Sri Santosh Gopal-Founders, Karnataka Syndicate Foundation, Bangalore.

The programme was anchored by Sumera M C and invocated by Akash D T. Rekha of 3<sup>rd</sup> year B.Sc welcomed all the dignitaries on the stage in her welcome speech.

#### Objectives:

- 1. Empower students to make appropriate decisions related to use of tobacco, alcohol and other drugs.
- 2. Emphasize an awareness of the negative effect of tobacco exposure.
- 3. Encourage the students to lead Addiction free life for better health.

Ms.Shyama Vijayaraghavan emphasized on the effects of tobacco exposure and its ill-effects from primary to tertiary persons. She informed that exposure to nicotine can have effects on adolescent brain development. Cigarette smoking also causes shortness of breath and reduces lung growth and early cardiovascular damage. Immediate quitting of smoking is not advisable and quitting smoking reduces risks for diseases caused by smoking and improves health.

Dr. Deepti N explained about healthy lifestyle and good eating habits. She said junk food affects our health and causes serious complications. Junk food is also one of the main reasons for the increase in obesity and causes nutritional deficiencies nowadays. Addiction to junk food in future reduces the life span.






