



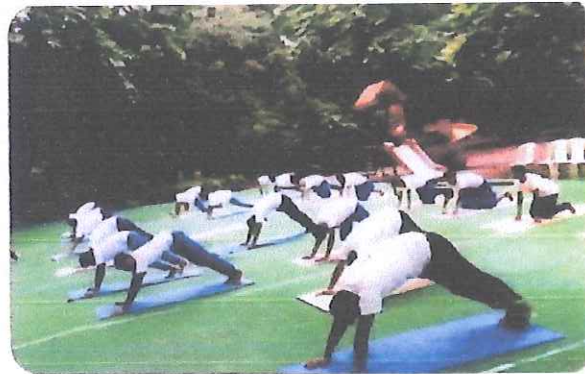

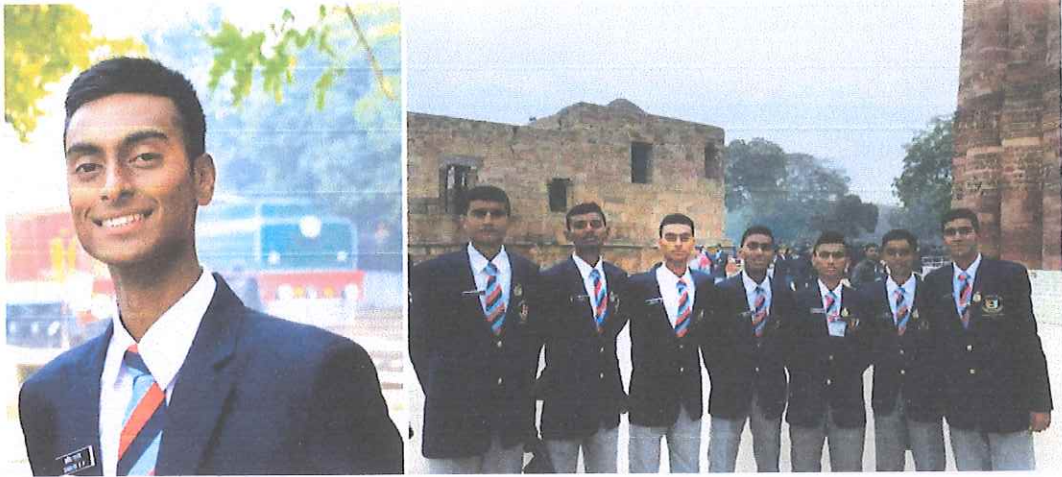

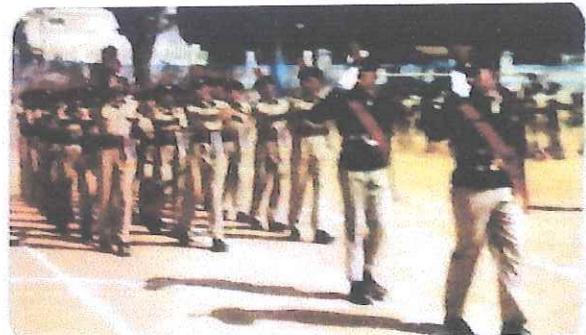

Kargil Vijay Diwas was celebrated on 27/07/2019 that was organized by NCC unit and paid tributes to Kargil martyr.

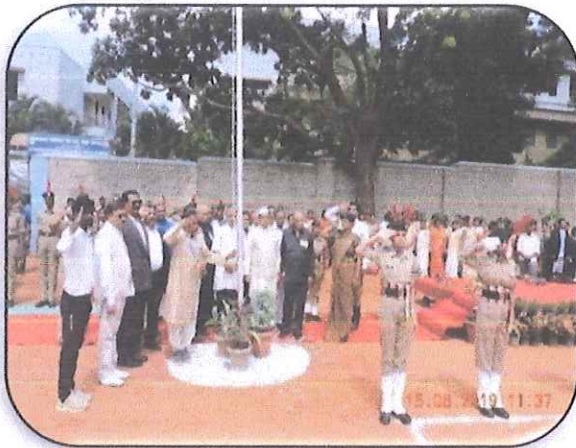

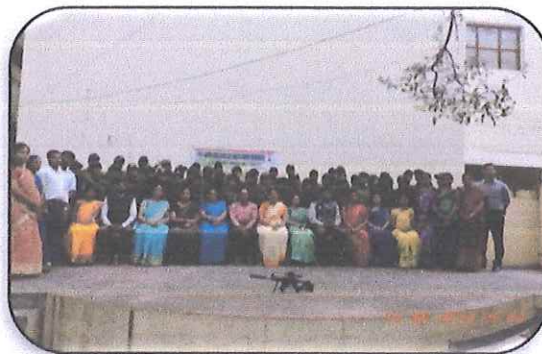
The film show regarding Quit India Movement was conducted by Department of History on 08/08/2019 as a part of curricular enrichment.

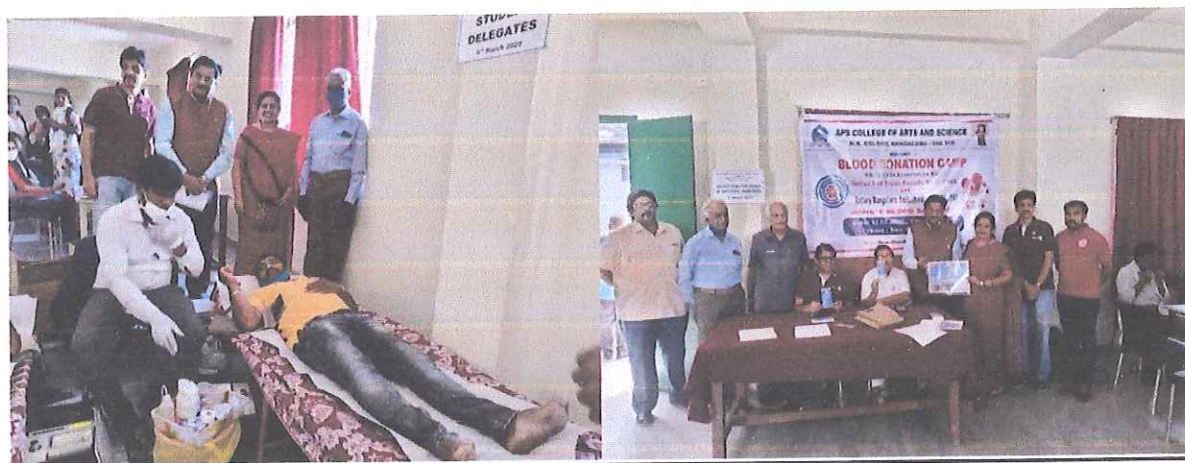

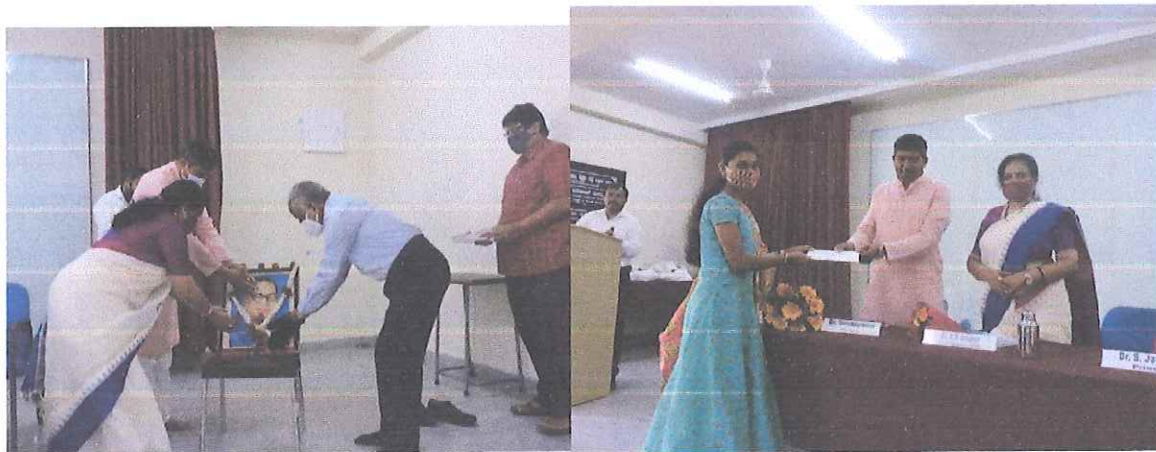

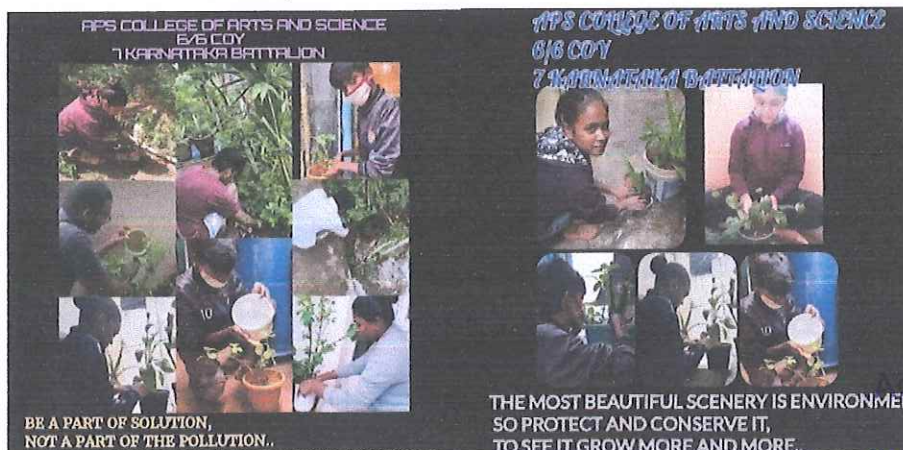
