ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2016-2017



Another distinguishing event is our college got a score of 70.63 as assessed by the Local Inquiry Committee, Bangalore University the highest score among the colleges of this area.





Department of Economics (UG) organized essay competition on the topic e Marketing in India on 15-06-2021.




